### E. Verbs in different tenses

- 3rd person singular (positive statements) = he/she/it

present: breaks - is breaking - is broken  
past: broke - was breaking - was broken  
will: will break - will be breaking - will be broken  
present perf.: has broken - has been breaking - has been broken  
past perf.: had broken - had been breaking - had been broken

- 1st person singular (questions) = I

present: do I love - am I loving - am I loved  
past: did I love - was I loving - was I loved  
will: will I love - will I be loving - will I be loved  
present perf.: have I loved - have I been loving - have I been loved  
past perf.: had I loved - had I been loving - had I been loved

- 2nd person plural (negative statements) = you

present: don't lose - aren't losing - aren't lost  
past: didn't lose - weren't losing - weren't lost  
will: won't lose - won't be losing - won't be lost  
present perf.: haven't lost - haven't been losing - haven't been lost  
past perf.: hadn't lost - hadn't been losing - hadn't been lost
